



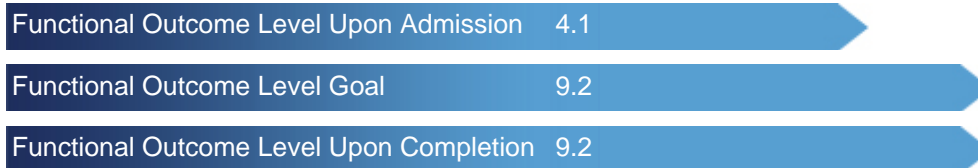
Your patient, Lillian Shields, was admitted to Concordia Transitional Care and Rehabilitation on 12/19/2017. A customized rehabilitation program was implemented to address functional deficits related to the diagnosis of UTI.

After successfully completing the therapy program at Concordia Transitional Care and Rehabilitation, Lillian Shields was discharged to home.

The patient's rehabilitation treatment program consisted of the following skilled interventions:

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY: 6x/week x 8 weeks
PHYSICAL THERAPY: 6x/week x 8 weeks
SPEECH THERAPY: 0x/week x 0 weeks
